

In 2024–2025, we strengthened our internal systems by focusing deeply on compliance and accounting standards, ensuring transparency and long-term sustainability. One of the most powerful moments this year was when we distributed 12,000 fruit-bearing trees in just one week—not merely planting trees, but planting futures. We received our 12A and 80G certifications, a significant milestone that strengthens our ability to grow while staying compliant and transparent. And people came forward—because truth, when lived with sincerity, always finds support.

To every volunteer, every supporter, and every person who stood with us silently or actively—thank you. Whether you cooked a meal, planted a sapling, bought a T-shirt, or simply shared a message—you were a part of something that truly matters.







FUTURE PLANS




LIAP Office in Beed
